Item 1 – Festival

We have a large camp this year so everyone needs to do their part to help make the camp run smoothly and respectfully for all.

- 1. Maelgwyn: Who has booked?

- 2. Maelgwyn: Does anyone need help with anything?
 - a. Bertrand: Food referred to Rowany College Food Fund by Katherne
 - b. Veronica-Claire: Ticket
 - 1. Emlyn offers to help with personal savings
- 3. Bethany: Reminder that we are sharing a space and to mind our fellow SCAdians gear while using common areas.
 - a. This is especially true of chairs!

- 4. Maelgwyn: To bring fire pit if space allows
 - a. All Adoran campers to bring their own bag of firewood
- 5. Maelgwyn: A tenth anniversary party/birthday party on the Monday night (though this can be flexible depending on the festival schedule) with bonfire, drinks and giggles.
 - a. Members to bring a 6-pack of beverages or nibbles to share (think "mini-feast").
 - b. Aelfred will be celebrating his 40th birthday at the same time so it will be a combined event.
- 6. Bethany: Hosting a casual camp decoration competition for the group.
 - a. A non-official, relaxed competition to make something decorative for the campsite. IE: Banners, torches, pretty hangings and everything in between.
 - b. The winner, to be chosen by Bethany on festival Friday, will receive the awesome gift of delicious tasty sweets!

- 2. Maelgwyn: The next A&S day will be for dancing training and practice
 - a. Emlyn: to organise venue at the uni
 - b. Brian: Will lead as Dance Master
- 3. Must be done before Flametree Ball

Item 5 – Stitch Date and Time

The new venue seems to be working out very well.

- 1. There has been an increase in numbers, both new and old members
- 2. More accessible for most
- 3. Please remember that Friday night stitch is gold coin donation and the Shire's only method of income
- 4. Veronica-Claire: There was a proposal to have a Monday night fighter training
 - a. Maelgwyn: People who have armour and want to fight are limited
 - b. Emlyn: The College is looking for donations to go towards fighting: helms, swords, shields, reconditioned rapiers and fencing masks
- 5. Seth: Can now Marshal

- 6. Maelgwyn: Because we don't have a Shire trainer, would it be worth bringing people from Sydney?
 - a. Emily: Will need to get Shire commitment first
 - b. Everyone will contribute \$5-\$10 to help with fuel costs
 - c. We will need more people interested in fighting and training before committing to bringing Sydney fighters down
 - d. Will revisit our options after Festival
- 7. Seth: It is reasonably easy to make your own shield
 - a. Materials needed: Plywood (Bunnings will cut this to size for free), aluminium tubing and garden hose
- 8. Maelgwyn: If you are interested in fighting contact him
- 9. Aelfred: Is anyone fighting at festival?
 - a. No one is authorised apart from Aelfred and Dan

- 1. Bertrand: Would like to see more members showing interest in calligraphy
 - a. He and Katherne to run classes to help those new to the art
 - b. If you are interested, email Katherne
- 2. Maelgwyn: To speak to Xavier about sheet metal donated to the college
